Recovery of Items Taken in Burglaries

Sheriff Jimmy Harris states as follows:

In following up an investigation into Charles A. Dunn, who was arrested on April 9 in connection with the burglary of a Sylvania residence, Sheriff's Office Investigators and Powell Police Department Officers recovered a number of stolen items from a residence in the Powell community. Among the items recovered were several hunting rifles, shotguns, a handgun, computers and computer accessories, a flat screen TV, photographic equipment, and hunting equipment. The items are believed to have come from three separate burglaries in the Sylvania area that occurred between January and March of this year, one of which was previously reported as having been committed by Dunn on March 9.

Dunn's participation into the additional burglaries is being investigated further, and other leads and suspects are also under investigation in connection with the burglaries. Additional arrests are expected. Dunn remains in jail at this time, charged with Burglary 3rd Degree, Theft of Property 2nd Degree, and Receiving Stolen Property 3rd Degree. He is also being held in connection with probation violation from Jefferson County's Office of Probation and Parole.
