Sheriff Jimmy Harris states as follows:

On July 18, 2009 DeKalb County Sheriff's Deputies arrested Romando Shane Bright on a Burglary 3<sup>rd</sup> warrant. The warrant stemmed from an investigation done by Inv. Hal Nash, of a Burglary report made to the DeKalb County Sheriff's Office on July 11, 2009. The report stated that a home in the Crossville community had been burglarized. During Inv. Nash's interview, Mr. Bright admitted to the burglary of the home in Crossville and also admitted to burglarizing a home in Geraldine on the same night. The burglary report of the home in Geraldine was also being investigated by the Sheriff's Office. Mr. Bright was then charged with a second count of Burglary 3<sup>rd</sup>.

At the time Mr. Bright was arrested he had on him several items of jewelry that were stolen from the home in Crossville, these items were returned to the owner. Mr. Bright told Inv. Nash where some of the stolen items from the home in Geraldine were located, these items were recovered and returned. Mr. Bright is currently being held and is awaiting bond at the DeKalb County Detention Center.
